

FISHERY RULES FOR SAFETY FROM COVID-19
MARCH 2022

1. No-one with Covid-19 symptoms, without first testing negative, is to visit any of our fisheries
2. Members may bring guests in line with normal Fishing Section rules. Guests must be made aware of these rules and given a copy. They must adhere to them and it is the member's responsibility to ensure they do.
3. Please sanitise hands after opening gates or lodge/huts/signing in box. Hand sanitiser gel will be provided at the signing in point of each fishery
4. Fishing huts and sign in box are open and you must sign in before fishing and complete catch return and sign out after fishing
5. Doors to fishing huts are to remain open when the huts are occupied
6. Net dips to be used. If a net has been used at Bushells you must either dip the net after fishing or use a second net if intending to fish one of our other fisheries
7. Everyone fishing alone should advise someone of their whereabouts and approximately how long they will be before going to our fisheries (e.g. wife, other relative etc.) Carrying a fully charged mobile phone would be an advantage
8. At the Brook only, each car visiting must have a note in the windscreen saying how many people are fishing from that vehicle and the time of arrival.
9. Maximum number of people fishing at any one time at the Brook will be 4
10. Maximum number of people fishing at any one time at the Bushells Lake, Ullenhall will be 4 plus up to two in the boat
11. The boat at Bushells Lake will be available provided the boat rules are adhered to
12. The toilet at Great Alne may be used but please wash hands thoroughly after use
13. All other rules to be observed as usual
